TomTom navigation is seamlessly integrated in the "Italian style" quality of the dashboard, through the two Connect NAV systems with 6,5" and 8,4" screens, developed together with Magneti Marelli.

The Alfisti drivers will benefit from TomTom's state-of-the-art NavKit Engine, including future software releases. In synergy with TomTom 2,5D and 3D Maps, delivered by TomTom's intelligent map-making process, Alfisti will enjoy TomTom's superior turnby-turn navigation, featuring advanced lane guidance to navigate even the most complex junctions. Drivers will also have the advantage of TomTom Routes, providing the fastest route based on actual speed data, for mapped roads, during any time of the day and day of the week.
